SHORT RECITAL:

The Assam Chah Mazdoor Sangha raised the demand for enhancement of House Rent Allowance granted to the permanent workers in tea plantations vide agreement, the last one of which was signed between the ACMS and the Employers' Associations on 13th December

At a bipartite meeting held at Dibrugarh on 4th June 2018 the following agreement has been reached with regard to House Rent Allowance:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT:

- a) i) That a non-resident permanent worker of a tea plantation residing in his owr accommodation outside the estate entitled to a housing accommodation within the plantation under Section 15(B) of the Plantation Labour Act will receive a House Rent Allowance of Rs300/- (Rupees Three Hundred) per month.
 - ii) Eligible permanent workers residing within the estate if not provided any housing accommodation will be entitled to House Rent Allowance at the same rate as above per month till such time he/she is provided housing accommodation.
- b) In the event of any such worker refusing allotment of housing accommodation offered by the management, the worker will not be entitled to receive House Rent Allowance.

- c) If any non-resident/resident permanent worker is already in receipt of better facilities in respect of housing he/she would continue to enjoy the same but in that case the concerned worker will not be entitled to the house rent.
- d) This agreement will take effect from 1st June, 2018.
